Ena Mulavdic and Ebrahim Mohammadian are jewellery designers and artists who work together on their exceptional jewellery designs. They have founded their own jewellery brand “EM Jewellery” in 2016.

The story of the EM Jewellery has its beginning in Istanbul, where Ena and Ebrahim have met in 2013. While both came from different cultures and met in equally multicultural Istanbul, they had much to share about their lifestyles and world outlook. At that time Ena was studying her master’s degree in Industrial Design at Mimar Sinan University, while Ebrahim was working as a thriving young freelance artist and jewellery designer.

The idea for creating a common brand came after three beautiful years of caring friendship, mutual support and genuine understanding of each other’s philosophy of life. Moreover, the mixture of different cultures and origins that they have in common was appealing and winsome, bringing a special charm into their friendship and peculiarly into EM Jewellery brand.

Statement

EM Jewellery emerged as a collaboration of two friends, both interested in arts and design.

We make jewellery with greatest passion and commitment. This is based on our belief that everything in this world is connected with each other, therefore we strive to pass high values through our jewellery art.

Every single piece of our work is unique and deeply deliberated. Accordingly, we strive to make our art tangible in both spiritual and structural manner. Our jewellery is not constrained by established symbols. Our Jewellery Artworks

Our main activity is fine handcrafted jewellery, with the special emphasis on handcrafted rings. Our approach to jewellery is mainly artistic, but in the same time we strive to gain the craftsmanship perfection, which defines a true masterpiece. Moreover, we are very devoted to the artistic aspect of our jewellery, since we are sure that it brings an additional and timeless value.

Our craftsmanship values are expressed through cautiously handcrafted silver or gold and negative intaglio technique, where sculptures are meticulously carved into the reverse side of a precious or semi – precious stone. This way, we gain the three – dimensional effect, which makes the stone very appealing.

In the other hand, the artistic values are expressed through various artistic techniques. First of all, our most common technique in our work is miniature oil painting on various surfaces (gold, silver, wood, egg shell, precious and semi - precious stone etc.). The specificity of these oil paintings is that they are made in three – dimension, so that they bring vividness to our jewellery. Oil paintings are always combined with enamel colors, which allows us to make different three – dimension effects on oil paintings.

Moreover, in our work we often use eggshell as a very traditional and antique medium on which we make bas – reliefs or oil miniature paintings. Our work is always combined with miniature scale sculptures in metal (silver or gold) or precious wood, where we strive to gain a highly artistic value required by the art sculpture standards. All these and many other techniques that we use less often are in a charge of making an indeed timeless, valuable and remarkable artistic and jewellery masterpiece.

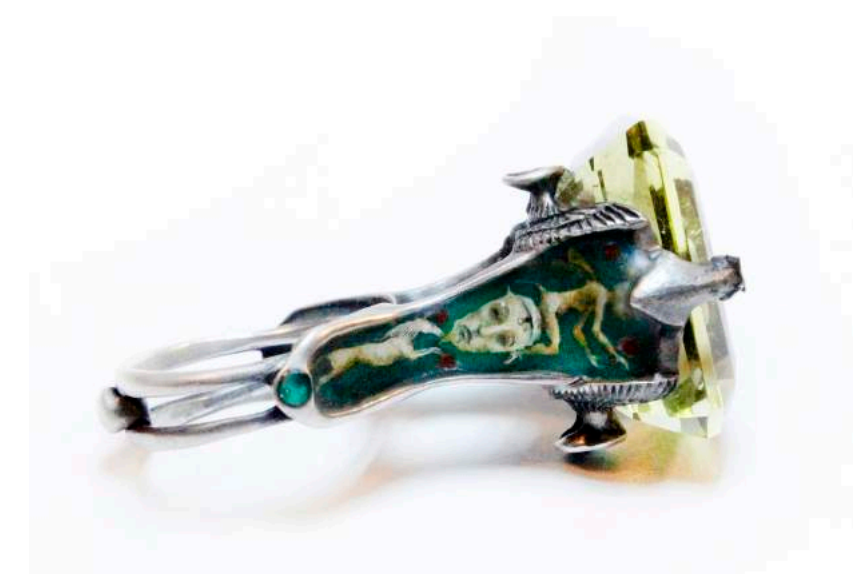

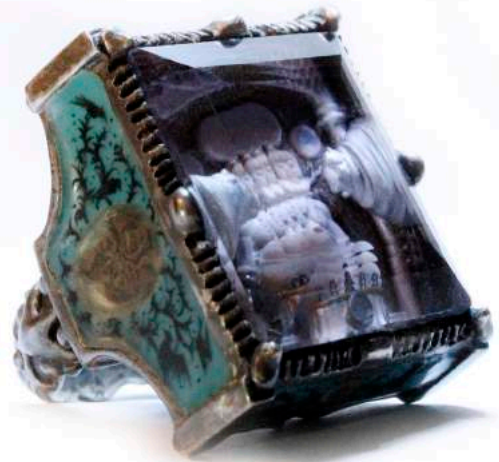
